- 1. Period: April 1, 2019 August 31, 2019 (5 months)
- 2. Application Deadline: Wednesday, October 31, 2018 (Japan Standard Time)
- 3. Admission notification: Mid-December 2018
- 4. The objectives of this program are:
 - (1) to improve students' Japanese language proficiency in order to enable them to interact with Japanese speakers and to conduct research in Japanese;
 - (2) to acquire basic knowledge and methodology for Japanese studies especially relating to Japanese general and applied linguistics;
 - (3) to gain a deeper understanding of Japanese language and culture through various courses.

- (1) Those who will be 18 years old to 29 years old on April 1, 2019.
- (2) Those who major Japanese language and culture in the undergraduate courses of the university wide agreement partners of Hokkaido University. (department-wide agreement partners not eligible) First-year students are not eligible to apply. Those who have finished introductory level and reached intermediate level of Japanese language study at the time of submission: those who passed N3 or above level of the Japanese Language Proficiency Test, or have equal ability with successful applicants of
